Additional information

Location

The IFISC building is located at the campus of the Universitat de les Illes Balears (UIB) which is outside the city of Palma. If the number of participants would increase significantly we will look for an alternative location within the UIB campus thus the main points of the information that follows will not change.

There is a metro from Palma every 20 minutes. In particular there is a metro departing from Palma (Plaza España) at 8:35 and arriving to UIB campus at 8:48. Walking from the metro station at UIB campus to IFISC building is 5 minutes.

Itinerary

We recommend arriving to Mallorca by flight. Palma Airport (code PMI) is a quite large airport with flights to many European cities, in particular German and UK cities, besides multiple connections per day to Madrid and Barcelona, which are the main hops in Spain.

Hotels suggestions

Since the campus is outside the city, there are no hotels nearby. The most convenient hotels are those close to Plaza España where the metro to the UIB Campus departs:
